

#### **NEW FROM TRANSPORTATION**

For the 2022-2023 school year, the Transportation Department will be implementing ZONAR ZPass bus passes and scanners for each regular route. This will aid the Transportation Department in payment of fees and let them know if a student has boarded or not boarded the school bus, as they must scan their bus pass as they get on and off the bus. There will be a one-time scanner bus pass with the option to pay for the bus monthly or annually. Bus passes will still be \$36.75 per month or \$367.50 annually. (Family Plan will be \$32.00 per month. For Family Plan pricing you must have 3 or more students in any ECSD school who take the bus). Please ensure that each monthly bus fee is paid as the bus scanners will be deactivated and the student may not be allowed to ride the bus.

# PICKING UP YOUR CHILD?

Parents/Guardians, please remember that if you are picking up your child during school hours, you <u>MUST</u> ring the front door doorbell, let the office staff know who you are picking up and the office staff will call your child down to the office. The student will be walked to the front door. At this time, the parents may come into the vestibule and sign their child out in the sign out book. If your child normally takes the bus home and you decide to pick them up, pleased ensure that you <u>let the bus driver or their bus supervisor know</u> that the student will not be taking the bus, this is so we may mark them off our list and the bus does not wait for a student that has already gone home.

On <u>September 28 th</u>, we will once again be participating in the Terry Fox School Run. Last year, we came together as a school family and raised \$1, 231.25. for the Terry Fox Foundation. This year, we challenge you to try to match or beat our goal of \$1000.00 We will be participating in a variety of activities to help support Terry Fox's dream of coming closer to a cure for cancer. Here is a list of activities that will encourage our students to contribute fully with their "Body, Mind and Spirit":

- Toonies for Terry: with a \$2 donation, students can purchase a paper running shoe and write their name on it. Parents can also send in toonies and have their names, or the names of those who have passed away, placed on a shoe as well. We will be placing these shoes around the Terry Fox poster in the atrium and hope to cover the entire wall by the run on September 28 th. Donations of \$10 will get a big shoe to display. Donations are welcome starting this week and will be accepted until **Thursday, September 28th**. Dear Parents,

Greetings! Let me introduce myself. My name is Fr. Mark McGee and I am the Pastor of St. Thomas More Catholic Church (210 Haddow Close). Your school falls within my parish boundaries, and so I have a Pastoral responsibility for your school.

# IN CASE YOU WERE WONDERING



The RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) process is the way adults come into "Full Communion" with the Catholic Church (i.e. those baptised in another Christian church); or those never Baptised prepare for the Sacraments of full Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist). The Catholic community of St. Thomas More is happy to support anyone wishing to embark on this Journey of Faith. There is lots to learn and the experience is transformative. If this is something you are considering you may call the parish office (780) 434-6313 and leave your name and number. Also, an information session regarding the RCIA process called "Nicodemus Night" (see John 3:1-21 is scheduled for Sunday, September 25 at 1:30 pm at St. Thomas More (210 Haddow Close). Perhaps you might even like to attend on behalf of someone else or to support a friend. Attendance at "Nicodemus Night" will not require a decision or commitment.

A parish communication platform called "Flocknote", will be used for information sharing. If you have any questions please speak to pastoral assistant Julie Lee. We meet six Wednesdays, 4:30-5:45 pm. (3x's for 1st Confession + 3x's for 1st Eucharist) Parental involvement is an essential element of your child's preparation. Material costs will be \$30.00 total for both sacraments.

#### **WONDERING ABOUT CONFIRMATION?**

The Parent Information and Registration meeting for Confirmation is on **TUESDAY**, **OCTOBER 4**<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at 6-7:30 pm. Along with Service Projects and increased parish participation, Confirmation classes are scheduled on Saturday mornings, 10:00 am – 12 noon, the first one being October 22<sup>nd</sup>. The Sacrament of Confirmation will be celebrated at 2 Masses, 2 pm and 5 pm on Sunday, April 30, 2023. Parents and Sponsors are also given clear roles and their involvement is an essential element of your child's preparation.
